71	<u>Chardonnay, Cakebread 2007 Napa Valley, CA</u> Vibrant citrus blossom, ripe apple, melon and white peach aromas, with subtle hints of butter cream and toasted oak lead to sleek, succulent, ripe peach, yellow apple and lemon zest flavors buoyed by a vein of minerality, which enlivens the crisp, flavorful finish.	\$60.00
72	<u>Pinot Noir, Foley "Rancho Santa Rosa" 2006 Santa Rita Hills, Sonoma, CA</u> Deep garnet in color with purple highlights. Aromas of black cherry, blackberry and blueberry lead to well integrated tannin in this plump, mouth-filling wine.	\$48.00
73	<u>Meritage, Rodney Strong "Symmetry" 2004 Russian River Valley, Sonoma, CA</u> An opulent bouquet of blackberries, ripe dark plums, sweet spices and earth. The wine opens generously on the palate with layers of blackberry, cassis and plum framed with accents of dark chocolate and spice. The finish is persistent and smooth.	\$80.00
74	<u>Cabernet Sauvignon, Joseph Phelps 2005 Napa, CA</u> Dark ruby in color and resembling a classic Bordeaux both in aromatics and flavor. Smooth textured, supple and harmonious, with subtle layers of currant, spice, herb, anise and light oak, ending with a graceful mix of ripe fruit and fine-grained tannins.	\$85.00
75	<u>Masi, Amarone Classico 2004 Veneto, Italy</u> Clean, very powerful and complex on the nose with good backbone amid the sweet aromas of dried prunes and raisins. Soft and dry on the palate with baked cherry flavors and hints of cocoa and cinnamon. Attractively long finishing and full-bodied with soft tannins.	\$90.00
76	<u>Antinori Pian delle Vigne, Brunello 2001 Tuscany, Italy</u> Aromas of exotic fruit with cherry, coffee and toasted oak. Full-bodied, rich, opulent and fruity with well rounded tannins.	\$100.00
77	<u>Alvaro Palacios, "Finca Dofi" 2003 Priorat, Spain</u> Deep ruby in color. The nose combines cinnamon and exotic spice with fresh and dried fruits. Sweet, smoky and decadent.	\$110.00
