44	<b><u>Chardonnay, Stryker 2005 Russian River Valley, CA</u></b> On the nose, fig & hazelnut grab your attention, followed by spicy pear & honey on the palate. Elegant & refined, flavors of melon & apple linger on the finish which is accompanied by a conspicuous oak influence.	\$45.00
47	<b><u>Meritage, Stryker "E-1-K" 2002 Sonoma County, CA</u></b> Deep ruby red in color this wine opens with aromas of violets, licorice and mint. Ultra ripe plum and black cherries immediately jump out on the tongue chased by cassis and blackberry. Intricate layers start to unfold revealing chocolate, tea then spice. Tightly wound, but seamless, the tannins are held together with a creamy vanillin character and firm oak undertones. <b>Gold Medal winner: 2006 San Francisco Chronicle</b>	\$90.00
48	<b><u>Cabernet Sauvignon, Stryker 2004 Sonoma County, CA</u></b> A medium to full-bodied wine, it opens to aromas of black cherry, blackberry and cola and is framed with hints of maple and vanilla. It is well balanced, smooth and nicely structured showcasing the rich, ripe fruit flavors. The lengthy finish is highlighted by soft but age worthy tannins. <b>Two Gold Medals This Year</b>	\$47.00
49	<b><u>Cabernet Sauvignon, Stryker "Speedy Creek" 2003 Knights Valley, CA</u></b> Darkly colored and richly textured, this wine is packed with layers of ripe fruit flavors and notes of spice that add to its complexity. The fruity palate is supported by a backbone of firm but fine-grained tannins.	\$56.00
50	<b><u>Merlot, Stryker "Estate" 2005 Alexander Valley, CA</u></b> Richly colored, it opens with aromas of red cherries, chocolate and herbs that are nicely framed by cedary oak influences. On the palate, flavors of tart strawberry, clove and blueberry broaden this must-have wine. The finish is full of black cherry soda with a touch of coffee and chocolate. <b>Gold Medal 2007 San Francisco Chronicle</b>	\$42.00
53	<b><u>Syrah, Stryker "Estate" 2002 Alexander Valley, CA</u></b> A medium bodied wine with thick aromas of dark fruit and sweet toasted oak lead to a burst of fruit with hints of spice and a finish of fresh blackberries	\$40.00
